The Town of Andrews met in regular session on December 15, 2005 at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Curtis Dorsey presiding in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act. Mayor Dorsey called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

The invocation was rendered by Council Member-elect Thomas Alford.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call was held. Council Members present were: Terrance Middleton, Rodney Giles, Patsy Greene and Mayor Curtis Dorsey.

The minutes of the November 17, 2005 meeting were included in the council member's packets for their review. Council Member Giles made the motion to approve the minutes and was seconded by Council Member Greene. Motion carried.

The monthly financial statement was included in the council member's packets for their review. This was for information only.

Citizen's comments: Judge Ben Dunn stated that he was speaking on behalf of the citizens and merchants. He stated that the effort has been great in improving the town and that downtown looks beautiful. Mayor Dorsey stated that the comments were appreciated.

Old Business: Mayor Dorsey stated that the newly elected council members will be sworn in at the January 2006 regular meeting. Mayor Dorsey thanked staff members for the effort and hard work toward the "Christmas on Main" festival along with the Christmas parade.

Administrator's Report: Ms. Bradley handed out listing of next five properties to be cleaned up. This is the second list. She stated that the properties from the first list are being worked on.

Presentation by Boyd & Associates: Mr. Reese Boyd handed out copy of bids for the Railroad Bed Project to Mayor and Council Members. Mr. Boyd stated that he will send a detailed report to Ms. Bradley and she will forward it to council members for their review before proceeding.

Council Report: Council Member Giles asked that the town make certificates for participants in the Christmas Festival. Towanda McClary, clerk stated that she would make the certificates. Council Member Middleton requested that council member-elects be included in the process concerning the Railroad Bed project so that they are knowledgeable once they take office.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Dorsey stated that the next council meeting has been scheduled for January 12, 2006. Mayor Dorsey wished everyone a Merry Christmas. He stated that the staff Christmas party would be held on the upcoming Friday night at the Dorsey's Building and invited council members to attend.

Council Member Middleton made the motion to adjourn and was seconded by Council Member Greene. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
